Genesis 11: “The Aim of Sinners and the Heart of God”

Question: Why does God intervene in sinners’ affairs?

Big Idea: Sinners destructively seek their glory but God graciously intervenes to save.

Ice Breaker: Tell about an experience you’ve had with people who speak a language other than English.

Dig:

1. Why did the people decide to build this tower? What was wrong with their idea? Why?
2. What does God do? Why? Did His action have the intended outcome? How are the consequences still felt today?
3. How is “unity in Christ” different from the unity at Babel?

Apply:

4. In what ways do pride and rebellion against God inevitably lead to an inability to understand and be understood by others? What remedy(ies) have you found helpful?
5. What towers of pride and/or rebellion are you building in your own life? What lessons from this study are you applying to those towers?
