- 3. Contrast a) rest and activity, b) fear and comfort, c) danger and security, d) want and provision, and e) the present and the future? What do these contrasts reveal about God and man? Which speaks most loudly to you right now?

- 4. How have you experienced the Lord as your Good Shepherd?
- 5. What "dark valley" do you walk now? How is your "cup overflowing" now? Pray to your Good Shepherd about both of these. How did He respond?
