Jeremiah 30, “Deliverance through Grace,” Pastor Tim Cho

Q: What desires of God’s heart do we see through his promises to Israel?

Big Idea: God desires sin punished, sinners restored, and eternal peace established through Christ.

Ice Breaker: How far back do you date your “days of old”? Is that a past you would rather forget or are they the “good ol’ days”? Why?

Dig:

1. In Jeremiah 30:3, what promise sets up the theme for chapters 30 and 31? Who is included in the promise? Why?
2. From verses 5-15, how bad will things get for the Jewish people before deliverance arrives? Why?
3. From verses 8-11 and 16-24, what will the deliverance of Israel and Judah look like? What will it look like for their oppressors? How do these verses point to Jesus Christ?

Apply:

4. Right now, would you consider your situation to be more a time of restoration or a time of awaiting restoration? Either way, what reasons for hope do you take away from this passage?
5. Who do you know that is suffering now? How could you bring them hope and reassurance?
