GOD'S CALL TO MINISTRY PART III

Ephesians 3:7-13

In this passage, Paul gives the church at Ephesus seven characteristics of God's call to ministry. God calls us to ministry:

- 1. In His Prerogative (3:7a)
- 2. By His Preference (3:7a)
- 3. According to His Power (3:7b)
- 4. Regardless of our Position (3:8a)
- 5. For His Plan (3:9)
- 6. In accordance with His Purposes (3:10-11)
- 7. To reveal our Perseverance (3:12-13)

Psalm 115

- 1 Not to us, O Lord, not to us, But to Your name give glory Because of Your lovingkindness, because of Your truth.
- 2 Why should the nations say, "Where, now, is their God?"
- 3 But our God is in the heavens; He does whatever He pleases.
- 4 Their idols are silver and gold, The work of man's hands.
- 5 They have mouths, but they cannot speak; They have eyes, but they cannot see;
- 6 They have ears, but they cannot hear; They have noses, but they cannot smell;
- 7 They have hands, but they cannot feel; They have feet, but they cannot walk; They cannot make a sound with their throat.
- 8 Those who make them will become like them, Everyone who trusts in them.
- 9 O Israel, trust in the Lord; He is their help and their shield.
- 10 O house of Aaron, trust in the Lord; He is their help and their shield.
- 11 You who fear the Lord, trust in the Lord; He is their help and their shield.
- 12 The Lord has been mindful of us; He will bless us; He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron.
- 13 He will bless those who fear the Lord, The small together with the great.
- 14 May the Lord give you increase, You and your children.
- 15 May you be blessed of the Lord, Maker of heaven and earth.
- 16 The heavens are the heavens of the Lord, But the earth He has given to the sons of men.
- 17 The dead do not praise the Lord, Nor do any who go down into silence;
- 18 But as for us, we will bless the Lord From this time forth and forever.
