BIBLICAL INERRANCY

2 Timothy 3:16

- I. What do we mean when we say the Bible is without error (ie. inerrant)?
 - 1. Inerrancy means historical accuracy
 - 2. Inerrancy exists even when old testament texts are not recited verbatim in the new testament
 - 3. Inerrancy includes the use of figures of speech and different literary genres
 - 4.The Bible is inerrant even when it does not use the modern language of science
 - 5. Inerrancy does not guarantee the exhaustive comprehensiveness of any single account or combined accounts
 - 6. Inerrancy does not demand the infallibility of non-inspired sources used by biblical writers
- II. Why we should absolutely believe in biblical inerrancy
 - 1.The Bible itself claims to be perfect.
 - 2. The Bible stands or falls as a whole.
 - 3.The Bible is a reflection of its author.
 - 4. The Bible judges us, not vice versa.
 - 5. The Bible's message must be taken as a whole.
 - 6. The Bible is our only rule for faith and practice.
