THE WALK OF HOLINESS

Ephesians 4:17-32

In these verses, Paul describes the two main commands for the walk of holiness for the believer (we will cover the first command today).

You are (not) to live as:

- 1. The Heathen Ones (4:17-19)
 - a. You are not to walk:
 - i. In Futility (4:17)
 - ii.In Darkness (4:18)
 - iii. In Sensuality (4:19)
- 2. The Holy Ones (4:20-32)
 - a. You are to walk:
 - i. In the Truth
 - ii.In Renewal
 - iii. Consistent with the Law of Christ
