THE KING AND HIS GLORY

In Matthew 10:16–23, Jesus prepares His messengers for inevitable hostility by calling them to wise discernment, Spirit-dependent confidence, and faithful endurance to the end. The King's Messengers must:

- Exhibit Wise Character (16) [Review]
- Expect Real Conflict (17–18, 21–22) [Review]
- Entrust Themselves to the Holy Spirit (19–20) [Today]
- Endure to the End (Matt 10:22–23) [Today]
