In Matthew 10:5–15, the King establishes four foundational principles that govern the ministry of His messengers.

Questions for Young Children

Who sent the disciples to tell people about God?

What did Jesus want the disciples to tell people? (*Answer: The good news about God / the kingdom of heaven.*)

Did the disciples go by themselves, or did Jesus send them?

Who made us and loves us?

Who came to save us from our sins?

Should we tell people about Jesus?

When someone tells us about Jesus, should we listen?

When mommy and daddy tell us about Bible, should we pay attention?

Will you tell someone about Jesus?

Who could you tell about Jesus? (*Possible answers: a friend, sibling, grandma, etc.*)

Who helps us tell people about Jesus?
