Introduction to our Text

The Biblical Context of <u>1 Cor 15</u>

Exodus 3:13-15 LSB

¹³ Then Moses said to God, "Behold, I am about to come to the sons of Israel, and I will say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you.' And they will say to me, 'What is His name?' What shall I say to them?" ¹⁴ And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'" ¹⁵ And God furthermore said to Moses, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'Yahweh, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.' This is My name forever, and this is My memorial-name from generation to generation.

The resurrection of Christ was a basic theme of the Apostles' teaching

The Presence of the church (1 Cor 15:1-2)

¹⁸ "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.

²¹ From that time Jesus began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised up on the third day.

The Proof of the Scriptures (1 Cor 15:3-4)

1 Corinthians 15:3-4 LSB

³ For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins <u>according to the Scriptures</u>, ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day <u>according to the Scriptures</u>,

The Testimony of the Eyewitnesses (<u>1 Cor 15:5-8</u>)

Paul was an Uncommon Messenger (<u>1 Cor 15:8-10</u>)

The Apostles and Paul had Duplicate Messages (<u>1 Cor 15:8-11</u>)

⁸ and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to me also. ⁹ For I am the least of the apostles, and not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. ¹⁰ But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me.

¹¹ Whether then *it was* I or they, so we preach and so you believed.

Sermon Text

1 Corinthians 15:13-20 LSB

¹³ But if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised. ¹⁴ And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain. ¹⁵ Moreover we are even found *to be* false witnesses of God, because we bore witness against God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise, if in fact the dead are not raised. ¹⁶ For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised. ¹⁷ And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. ¹⁸ Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. ¹⁹ If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied. ²⁰ But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep.

Proposition and Outline

In <u>1 Cor 15:13-19</u>, the Apostle Paul warns of six disastrous consequences if there is no bodily resurrection for believers. If there is no bodily resurrection for believers, then:

Jesus has not been Raised (1 Cor 15:13)

All Biblical Preaching is Vain (1 Cor 15:14a)

Your Faith is Vain (1 Cor 15:14b)

The Gospel Message is a Lie (1 Cor 15:15–16)

You are Slaves to Sin, not Christ (1 Cor 15:17)

There is no Eternal life in Christ(1 Cor 15:18-19)

Jesus has not been Raised (1 Cor 15:13)

1 Corinthians 15:13 LSB

¹³ But if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised.

The Gospel message is a lie (1 Cor 15:15-16)

1 Corinthians 15:15-16 LSB

¹⁵ Moreover we are even found *to be* false witnesses of God, because we bore witness against God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise, if in fact the dead are not raised. ¹⁶ For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised.

You are Slaves to Sin (1 Cor 15:17)

The Gospel

God

Created and owns everything

Gen 1:1—In the beginning God created the Heavens and the Earth

<u>Psalm 24:1</u>—The earth is the Lord's, and all it contains, the world and those who dwell in it.

Is Perfectly Holy

<u>1 John 1:5</u>—This is the message we heard from Him and announce to you that God is light and in Him there is no darkness at all.

Matt 5:48—Therefore you are to be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect.

Requires perfect obedience to His Law

<u>James 2:10</u>—for whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one point, he has become guilty of all.

<u>Man</u>

Has broken God's law

<u>Rom 3:10,23</u>—there is none righteous, not even one...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

Will pay the eternal penalty for his sin

<u>Rom. 6:23</u>—For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord

Cannot save himself by his good works

<u>Titus 3:5</u>—He saved us not based on works which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit.

Christ

Came to earth both as God and sinless man

<u>Col 2:9</u>—For in Him the fullness of deity dwells in bodily form

Demonstrated God's love by dying on the cross to pay sin's penalty

<u>Rom 5:8</u>—But God demonstrated His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us

<u>2 Cor 5:21</u>—He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Rose from the grave and is alive today

<u>1 Cor 15:4</u>—And that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures

Sinners

Must repent of all that dishonors God

<u>Isa 55:7</u>—Let the wicked forsake his way and the unrighteous man his thoughts; and let him return to the Lord, and He will have compassion on him and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.

<u>Luke 9:23</u>—if anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take us his cross daily and follow Me.

Must believe in Christ as Lord and Savior

<u>Rom 10:9</u>—that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved.

Will you repent and believe in Christ?

<u>Acts 17:30</u>—therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance God is declaring to men that all everywhere should repent.
