The world sees Jesus' love when we walk in harmony. Conversely, when there is jealousy, envy, slander, gossip, bitterness, complaining, backstabbing, and resentment, people will leave and stay far away. No one is drawn to God when there is pride, division and strife. The prayers of Jesus continue to be answered and fulfilled when we are humble and guard the unity God has given us.
