WEEK 15:

Read: Romans Chapter 15

The God of hope wants to fill you with joy and peace when you trust Him. The infinite hope of Jesus is available in our hearts and homes. Church should be the most hope-filled place in our cities. The church is designed to influence the world, instead of the world influencing the church. The bolder the world is about sin, the bolder we need to be about Jesus. God will give you encouragement and endurance. When God gives the vision, He gives the provision. The Holy Spirit guides and provides. God begins a good work in you and is faithful to complete it. You are a minister, priest and ambassador for Jesus. You are who God says you are. Live out your calling in all places. People need Jesus more than they need their next breath. Paul wanted to visit Rome and bring the gospel to Spain. God is calling you to new relationships and places. He fills you with purpose and passion; He ignites a fire in your soul. There are no limits to what God can do. Don't try to shrink or deny the calling on your life. Make it your top priority and north star to hear God tell you: "Well done my good and faithful servant!"

Hope Point: Be intentional with your prayers and plans as you receive and give the hope of Jesus.
