

Dear Friends,

Thank you for your faithful prayers and support for our Chaplain ministry. As you know we provide immediate crisis intervention to all our agencies and local citizens. Among many other responsibilities over the last several months we have responded to 18 unexpected deaths. We gave assistance at several suicide cases which are heartbreaking to say the least...twice we were called to give aid when cyclists were hit by vehicles, seven times we were asked to help law enforcement give death notifications to immediate family members; we served families that suffered because of the Northern California Glass Fires (some of that aid was given at the local shelters where we worked with Aaron the Comfort Dog and team from St. John's Lutheran Church), assisted families at two drownings, and served a large family after a structure fire. We responded twice for our NPD Reconstruction Team where a 2 yr. was killed when accidentally run over and an adult killed when they mistakenly walked out on Hwy 29. Twice we provided crisis intervention to two families, gave aid after a shooting and a homicide involving another shooting. Our SWAT team requested our help twice, and assisted BGEA Team and families after the Northern CA Glass Fire. We were also asked to give personal counsel after some major family difficulties involving molestation, etc.

We have a great team that provides these professional services...
