So please pray so that we can know what is going to happen as far as the building is concerned if we are to move or to stay where we are at. Being that the church is built on federal property the government could come in relocate us at any time given. The church has been there for 30 years, and it has always been knowledge that the church



should have not been built there because of the government owning the land.

In the long run it has come to a point where it is going to affect us one way or another. So please pray as the information is going to be coming out little by little and not in a concrete confirming way that the government should communicate this. The bureaucracy is crazy in our country and even the most significant construction that this border crossing is going to be we have no clue what is going to happen. Talk about uncertainty.
