## Questions:

Warm Up:

1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?
2. Dr. Mohler called this passage a pillar for the Christian. Why do you think that was?

## Discussion:

1. Why do you believe Jesus used this specific parable to train His disciples?
2. How important is context to understanding parables (i.e. farming)?
3. What is a parable and why did Jesus speak in parables?
4. What did it mean when Jesus said, "to you it has been given, to them it has not been given."
5. What are the four soils? And how do we identify them?

## Application:

1. How is the sovereignty of God in Salvation a comfort to you as a Christian?
2. Have you thought about the usefulness of the disciples' confusion on these parables?
3. Understanding more of this parable, what has been your response?
4. What do you believe about the yield of your own heart?
