Seventy Weeks Prophecy, Part 3 Scott Ardavanis Daniel 9:25–26

Synopsis:

Three Insights that Reveal the End of the World, the Future of Israel, and the Coming Kingdom of God

- 1. The Person Sent by God (9:20–23)
- 2. The Prophecy Set Forth by God (9:24)
- 3. The Period of Time Secured by God (9:25–27)

Questions:

Warm Up:

- 1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?
- 2. This was Pastor Scott's 30th sermon in Daniel. What has stood out to you so far about the book of Daniel?

Discussion:

- 1. What is significant about the 70th week prophecy being written 500 years before its fulfillment? What does this say about God?
- 2. Read Daniel 9:24, What are the six purposes decreed in the 70th week? When will these purposes be finally fulfilled?
- 3. In v.24 what does it mean that God will bring everlasting righteousness, what does this point to? Read Jeremiah 23:5–6.
- 4. What were the three possibilities for the starting point of the 70 weeks?
- 5. Why is it significant that Jesus did not forbid his disciples from praising him during the triumphant entry? How does his entry relate to v.25 of Daniel 9?

Application:

- 1. John 1:10-11 states Jesus came to his own yet his own did not know him. What does this reveal about the human heart?
- 2. In what ways are we tempted to doubt God in our everyday lives?
- 3. Read Psalm 118:22–23. How can we be encouraged knowing that Jesus Christ was rejected for us?
- 4. Knowing that God ordained the very day in which He would send His own son to die for you, what is your response?
- 5. How does the character of God revealed in Daniel encourage you today?

Prayer Suggestion: This week, pray for the continued faithfulness of the church as it looks ahead to the coming kingdom.
