Seventy Weeks Prophecy, Part 4 Scott Ardavanis Daniel 9:27

Synopsis:

Three Insights that Reveal the End of the World, the Future of Israel, and the Coming Kingdom of God

- 1. The Person Sent by God (9:20–23)
- 2. The Prophecy Set Forth by God (9:24)
- 3. The Period of Time Secured by God (9:25-27)

Questions:

Warm Up:

- 1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?
- 2. This was Pastor Scott's 31th sermon in Daniel. What has stood out to you regarding the 70 week prophecy Pastor Scott taught through over the past four weeks?

Discussion:

- 1. Who did Scott say where the two different princes in Daniel 9:25-27?
- 2. What occured at the end of the 69th week? Read Mark 13:1-2
- 3. Why is there a gap of years between the 69th week and the 70th week? Read Isaiah 9:6, 61:2; Luke 4:16–22. (There are gaps in prophetic literature.)
- 4. Why did Gabriel not tell Daniel about the gap that was to come? Read Ephesians 3:4–6. What is the purpose of the Church age? See Romans 11:25
- 5. Who is it that makes a strong covenant with many for one week? Daniel 9:27

Application:

- 1. After the 69th week we have now entered into the Church age, what is significant about this time? How should it cause us to live our lives?
- 2. Should we live on mission with urgency during the Church age knowing that we do not know when the tribulation will begin? Why or why not?
- 3. Should we live in fear knowing the coming of the tribulation?
- 4. What does God's covenant with Israel reveal about His Character? If He keeps His promises with Israel, will He not keep His promises with His own elect? Read John 10:9
- 5. Scott mentioned at the end of his sermon to be, "Alert and ready," why is this and what does it look like practically?

Prayer Suggestion:

- Pray for the continued faithfulness of the church as it looks ahead to the coming kingdom.
- Pray for those in our church who have recently lost loved ones.
- Pray for the Elders of GCV as they seek to be faithful to lead this congregation well.
