Daniel's Final Vision and the Heavenly Messengers Scott Ardavanis Daniel 10:1–12

Synopsis:

In Chapter 10, three sequences emerge. The main theme emerges, God is in sovereign control over all kingdoms all the way to the end of time.

- 1. The Man of God in Mourning (10:1–3)
- 2. The Messengers of God in Majesty (10:4–12)
- 3. The Message of God from Heaven (10:13–21)

Questions:

Warm Up:

- 1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?
- 2. This was Pastor Scott's 32th sermon in Daniel. What stood out to you regarding the heavenly messenger's responses to Daniel's prayer and mourning.

Discussion:

- 1. Read Ephesians 6:12 Why was Daniel filled with mourning instead of joy in the start of this chapter? Scott introduced the sermon sharing that the most powerful forces are found in the spiritual world.
- 2. Who does Daniel see at the bank of the Tigris river in Daniel 10:4–6?
- 3. What was Daniel's response to seeing the preincarnate Christ? Daniel 10:7-9. See also, Isaiah 6:5, Job 42:5, Luke 5:8, Revelation 1:13-16, Acts 9.
- 4. What does the second messenger say to Daniel in 10:12?

Application:

- 1. How do the attributes displayed in the picture of the Preincarnete christ encourage us today? (Omniscient, Judgement, Power, Holiness etc)
- 2. Why is prayer such a crucial aspect for the life of the believer?
- 3. Come up with a list of things we can and should be praying for?
- 4. 1 Peter 5:8 says, "Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour." How are we to pray for our own souls and the souls of others?

Prayer Suggestion:

- Pray for greater faithfulness in our prayer lives.
- Pray for courage and opportunities to share the good news of the gospel this Easter season.
- Pray for protection for our Elders as they seek to be faithful to lead this congregation well.
