Radical Love Pt.5 Scott Ardavanis 1 Corinthians 13:5–7

Synopsis:

There are 15 actions cited that call every believer to Love one another in the body of Christ

- 1. Love is patient
- 2. Love is kind
- 3. Love does not envy
- 4. Love Does not boast
- 5. Love is not arrogant
- 6. Love is not rude
- 7. Love does not insist on its own way
- 8. Love is not irritable

- 9. Love is not resentful
- 10. Love does not rejoice in sin
- 11. Love rejoices with truth
- 12. Love always protects
- 13. Love always trusts
- 14. Love always hopes
- 15. Love always endures

Questions:

Warm Up:

- 1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?
- 2. What stood out to you regarding the message on "Radical Love Pt.6?
- 3. What was one way in which the testimonies of those who got baptized encouraged you?

Discussion:

- 1. What did Pastor Scott say can destroy a church quicker than anything else?
- 2. You may have heard that love is to be tolerant, but why can love not be tolerant to sin?
- 3. Read Philippians 4:8, how does this passage help us rejoice in the truth?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 4:8 and Proverbs 17:9, how are we called to respond to others' sin?
- 5. "As long as God's grace is operative, human failure is never final" Why is this true?

Application:

- 1. How can we encourage others when they stumble in sin instead of finding pleasure in pronouncing condemnation on their shortcomings?
- 2. In what ways do we subtly rejoice in unrighteousness instead of righteousness?
- 3. "Love gazes upon the best qualities of others but only glances at their poor qualities," How can we practice this with others?
- 4. What can we take away from Scotts last point, Love always endures?

Prayer Suggestion:

- Pray for continued unity amongst the saints at GCV, so that we would be known by our love. That God would help us put on compassionate hearts, kindness, meekness and patience with one another. Would we remember daily the love that Christ has for us.
