Grace Group Discussion Guide

Knowing God's Peace Jack Barley Philippians 4:4–9

Synopsis:

Six characteristics to experience the peace of God.

- 1. Rejoices Always
- 2. Responds Gently
- 3. Refuses Anxiety
- 4. Prays Thankfully
- 5. Ponders Truth
- 6. Practices Obedience

Questions:

Warm Up:

1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?

Discussion:

- 1. What were some of the obstacles to rejoicing that the Philippians faced and what are some of the obstacles to rejoicing in your own life?
- 2. In Philippians 4:3, Paul reminds the saints at Philippi that their "names are in the book of life", how does this truth help one to rejoice? Read Romans 8:1.
- 3. Read Philippians 2:3-8. What aspects of Christ's example stand out to you?
- 4. Read Matthew 11:29, why is responding gently important?
- 5. What two ways could "the Lord is at Hand" be understood and how is this truth a comfort to you? What other verses come to your mind when you think of God's nearness?
- 6. Read 1 Peter 5:7, what is Peter's instruction and why is it important?

Application:

- 1. When do we become anxious? What are some examples in your own life?
- 2. If trusting in the Lord is the antidote to anxiety then what are some of the promises and characteristics of God that we must be trusting in?
- 3. In thinking about cultivating a heart of gratitude toward God, what are some of the many things that you are thankful for?
- 4. Read John 14:27, how does God's peace differ from the World's peace?
- 5. Which of the 6 virtues of Pondering Truth in Philippians 4:8 are most helpful or convicting when it comes to evaluating your own thought life?
- 6. What is the importance of practicing obedience?
