Questions:

Warm Up:

1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?

Discussion:

- 1. Scott discussed how an elder is not to have abusive authority, what does this mean?
- 2. What are some descriptions of this type of man? Think of some examples in Scripture of Abusive Authority (Violence) Cain, Moses, Peter etc.
- 3. Scott mentioned that an abuse of authority in the home often manifests itself in anger towards family members, how can we be on guard against this?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 2:23, 2 Timothy 2:24-25. How are you to respond after being reviled?
- 5. Pastor Scott said the elder is to not be greedy for gain, what happens when an elder becomes greedy for gain?
- 6. Read Matthew 6:19–24. What are some safe guards to protect against being greedy for gain in your own life?
- 7. Read 1 Timothy 6:5–11, Paul says that "Godliness with contentment is great gain". What are some heart motivations that should drive us as we strive to live lives that are above reproach?
- 8. What does it mean that an elder must be hospitable?
- 9. How were you challenged when it came to understanding the true meaning of hospitality?
