Questions:

Warm Up:

1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?

Discussion:

- 1. Read 1 Peter 1:1-2, What is the predicament that Dr. Mohler said we are in and Why is this only a temporary predicament?
- 2. Knowing that we are elect exiles, what confidence does this bring to believers?
- 3. Read 1 Peter 1:13–15. What did Dr. Mohler say was our assignment?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 2:11–15. What is the importance of living out this assignment?
- 5. Read 1 Peter 1:2-4. What is the believer's identity and what is it rooted in?
- 6. Read Romans: 5:1-5, What are some of the privileges of being in union with Christ?
- 7. Read 1 Peter 1:6–9. How precious is the atoning work of Christ if even Angels wish they could partake in this miraculous work? (1 Peter 1:12) What were the differences between man and angels that Dr. Mohler referred to?
- 8. What does it mean to fear God?
- 9. How can we show honor to the government around us and yet not fear them?
- 10. Read 1 Peter 2:12, What is the day of visitation? See also Matthew 5:16
- 11. Read 1 Peter 2:15. What are some practical steps we can take to "keep our conduct honorable" so that the ignorant may be silenced?
- 12. Read 2 Corinthians 4:16–18 & 1 Peter 1:3–5. We can face many trials and times of suffering in this life, how does our imperishable inheritance give us hope?
