Synopsis:

The quality of being above reproach is demonstrated in 3 areas of a man's life:

- 1. Home and Family life
- 2. His Personal Character
- 3. His Skill with the Word of God
 - a. His Personal Devotion
 - b. His Pastoral Duty.
 - c. His Pastoral Determination of the Word of God

4 TImeless Principles in responding to false teachers:

- 1. Recognize
- 2. Restrain
- 3. Rebuke
- 4. Reveal

Questions:

Warm Up:

1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?

Discussion:

- 1. How does the book of Titus describe how to recognize False Teachers? (Consider v.10)
- 2. Read Matthew 7:15–16. What does it look like for a man to be insubordinate?
- 3. Read 2 Timothy 2:16–18, 1 Timothy 6:3–5, and Titus 3:9. How is empty talk described? What examples can you think of when you have witnessed an empty talker?
- 4. What does it look like for the elders of the church to restrain false teachers?
- 5. Read 1 Timothy 6:5, what are false teachers often motivated by?
- 6. How are elders to rebuke false teachers? For what purpose?
- 7. Read Colossians 2:20-23 and 2 Tlmothy 4:3-4. False teachers are often accompanied by extra biblical manmade rules, what are some examples of extra biblical teachings?
- 8. What must be our response when we hear teaching that is not consistent with sound doctrine?
- 9. Considering the danger of False Teachers to the church, how important is it that members of the church become students of the word of God?
- 10. What is at stake if elders of the church do not expose false teachers?
