Questions:

Warm Up:

1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?

Discussion:

- 1. Read Acts 17:30. JP said that to enter by the narrow gate means that we are commanded to be converted. What does it mean that we are commanded to believe in Christ and repent?
- 2. Read John 3:16–18. Why is NOT making a decision, actually making a decision? And what is the danger of doing nothing?
- 3. Read Proverbs 1:7, 12:15, 13:20; What are the two paths the bible reveals people walk down?
- 4. In what way is the easy street a popular dead end?
- 5. Who is walking through the wide gate?
- 6. What makes the gate that leads to destruction, easy and wide?
- 7. What makes the gate that leads to life narrow?
- 8. JP said that the narrow gates leads to life, and that it can only be entered alone. What significance does this have on growing up in a christian family?
- 9. Many people come to Christ for the earthly benefits it brings without struggle. But what is the true reality of living a life for Christ? (Sacrifice, persecution, etc.)
- 10. What are some examples in your own life of what it has cost you to be a Christian?
- 11. What are some hindrances to people surrendering their life to Christ?
- 12. What does an exalted view of Christ do for the believer? (Endurance)
- 13. What is the importance of counting the cost before coming to Christ?
