Synopsis:

Three Requirements for Mankind

- 1. Do Justice
- 2. Love Kindness
- 3. Walk Humbly With God

Questions:

Warm Up:

1. What is one way that the sermon encouraged, exhorted, challenged, or corrected you?

Discussion:

- 1. Read 1 Samuel 15:22, Ecclesiastes 5:1, and Hosea 6:6. What does God ultimately command from his people? Why?
- 2. Pastor Chip used "Lady Justice," as an example of biblical justice. In what way does that picture point to biblical justice? (Sword, Scales, Blindfold)
- 3. How is Biblical Justice different from the way in which the world sees justice?
- 4. Read Matthew 5:13, How does being the salt of the earth coincide with doing justice? How can we make an impact for upholding righteousness in our own day? (Treat others in accordance with God's law. Don't show partiality towards others. Give others what is due to them.)
- 5. How should this term of kindness be understood? What is the difference between kindness and "niceness"?
- 6. Read Matthew 5:44, What did Pastor Chip say is the clearest way to see if you love kindness? (Love for unbelievers).
- 7. What does it look like in your life to walk humbly with God?
- 8. Pastor Chip reminded us that our vertical relationship with God will have a direct effect on our horizontal relationships. How so?
- 9. What are some of the heartless acts of self-righteousness that we tend to offer up to the Lord?
- 10. Read Micah 6:6-8. In light of verse 8 how are we to approach the throne of God?
