John 20:1–9

Synopsis:

The sight of the empty tomb is demonstrated in 2 specific eyewitness accounts:

1. Empty Tomb is Witnessed by Mary Magdalene
2. The Empty Womb Witnessed by Peter & John

Questions:

Discussion:

1. Read John 14:19, What is the believers hope that is found through the resurrection?
2. Why is it that so many people choose to reject the resurrection of Jesus Christ? What are some examples of this that you have seen in the lives of others?
3. Read John 20:8, John 2:18–22. The resurrection caused John to believe. Why?
4. Why are those who did not witness the resurrection more blessed according to the words of Christ in John 20:24–29? Read Hebrews 11:1
5. Read John 20:9. How have the scriptures been vindicated through the resurrection? (Hosea 13:14, Isaiah 26:19, 1 Corinthians 15, 50–58.)
6. What reality does the resurrection imply for the believer?
7. What was significant about the heart of Mary towards Jesus in this resurrection account? In other words, why do you think Mary loved the savior?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 4:13–18, 5:1–9. How does the resurrection give hope to those who are suffering and hurting?
9. How should the resurrection cause you to live your everyday life?
10. What is the purpose of John writing this Resurrection account? Read John 20:30-31, Romans 10:9.
