Teen Challenge

- GCV has a group of men that teach as well as come for support and encouragement to the students during their chapel service each Sunday night. Please pray for teachers as they preach the Word of God on Sunday nights.

- Pray for the staff at Teen Challenge as they lead by example, serve the students, pour into the lives of those who are overcoming addictions, and share the love of Christ.

- Pray for the men who are going through the program at Teen Challenge. Pray that they are surrendered to Christ, and that those who are not saved come to a saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus. Pray for their strength and endurance to continue in the program, even when it is difficult. Pray also for the families of the students who are at Teen Challenge.
