Titus 3:3-5a

Synopsis:

God gives four reminders for living in a pagan world

1. Remember Your Present Conduct
2. Remember Your Past Corruption
3. Remember Your Salvation

Questions:

1. How can being reminded of your past corruption help you walk in faithful witness to an unbelieving world?
2. What is humbling about remembering your former sins before Christ?
3. What comes to your mind when you understand there are people enslaved to the passions and pleasures of this world, unable to escape its vice?
4. Why is forgetting who you are before Christ a sense of pride?
5. How does Titus 3:4-5 reveal the sovereign work of God in salvation?
6. Read Ephesians 2:4-7, what type of love is demonstrated in God's goodness?
7. What are some ways God's goodness has been demonstrated in your life?
8. Why is it critical for the Christian to rehearse the Gospel to themselves every day?
