### Synopsis:

Four areas of remembrance of your responsibility in a pagan world

1. Remember Your Present Conduct
2. Remember Your Past Corruption
3. Remember Your Salvation
  - a. Goodness and Lovingkindness
  - b. Mercy

### Questions:

1. How is the mercy of God magnified in your past corruption?
2. Read Ephesians 2:8-9 and Romans 3:28; How is faith a mercy of God?
3. Why is the mercy of God so moving? Why does it fill the Christian with joy?
4. Why does mankind deserve punishment from a holy God?
5. How can the mercy of God bolster you to proclaim the gospel without fear to your neighbor? Read 1 Timothy 1:12-16
6. Read Romans 9:13-16, Is God's mercy fair if not everyone receives it?
7. Read Ephesians 2:1-5, How did the Holy Spirit redeem you? What is so miraculous about this work?
8. What person in your life do you need to tell of the gospel? (Share names a group and pray to that end)
