Questions:

1. Read Colossians 1:16-17, Hebrews 1:3, What is the scope of the power of God?
2. What drew the Lord of the universe; who needs nothing, to create mankind?
3. Consider the value of objects made by craftsmen...How much more should we consider the value of every person made by the master craftsmen?
4. How should all people be treated because they have been made by God?
5. Read v.13-14, How does the intimate language David uses depict the love of God for every person ever made?
6. Read v.15-16 How does this text deliver you to defend the sanctity of life in the womb?
7. Why should knowing God formed, made, and woven you give you contentment and comfort?
8. How does this text reveal that there is no "perfect" body but the Lord has made us with all of our defects and all for His glory?
9. Why should you see it as a privilege that you being made gives the Lord glory and praise?
