

Discussion Questions for Sunday, October 25, 1015

No Other Name | Acts 4:1-12

1. Read Acts 3:1–4:12. Trace the movement of this passage starting with the healing at the beautiful gate onto Peter's second and third sermons. What notable things do you observe?
2. Search the Scriptures! Find as many passages of Scripture that you can that support Peter's preaching that reveals what kind of Savior Jesus is.
 - A. Promised Savior. Christ/Messiah.
 - B. Powerful Savior. Power/Name.
 - C. Exalted Savior. Ps. 118:22. Cornerstone.
 - D. Exclusive Savior. Salvation in no one else. No other name.
 - E. Effective Savior. He really forgives and saves.
3. Read Psalm 118. What does it tell us about God and His character? What does it tell us specifically about Christ's work?
4. Discuss the 5 Solas (alone) of the reformation found in the following: "All praise to the Lord Jesus Christ. I have been saved by sovereign grace alone, through the gift of faith alone, in Christ alone, as revealed in Scripture alone, for God's glory alone." How do these truths reflect the fact that Jesus is the only savior?
5. What resolve does knowing that Jesus is the only Savior generate in your heart? How might it affect the types of things that you thought about last week 10/18/15 when hearing about preaching the gospel and making disciples?
6. Pray together utilizing the P-R-A-Y acrostic.
 - P**raise God. Acknowledge His character.
 - R**emember the Gospel. Recount Gospel truth.
 - A**dmit your need. Declare your dependence.
 - Y**ield to God. Commit everything to His sovereign good pleasure.
