27 Peace I leave with you; My [perfect] peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid. [Let My perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge.]

I have the right to come boldly before the throne of God to find mercy and grace in a time of need.

Hebrews 4:16Living Bible (TLB)

16 So let us come boldly to the very throne of God and stay there to receive his mercy and to find grace to help us in our times of need.

1 Corinthians 2:12-13The Message (MSG)
