Like many Lithuanians, he and his family had emigrated to Ireland about 10 years ago, but he recently returned to Lithuania without his wife and children. He joined the ministries of the church with some hesitation, but also with determination. He attends Bible study and prayer meetings and assists Pastor Frank van Dalen and other English-speaking pastors with translation during services.
 - * We first met Danute at a church service in Kedainiai after another member invited her last fall. She admitted that she rarely attended church and had little involvement with God or religion. Toward the end of our conversation, Rita encouraged her to join us more often. Since then, she has attended almost every service, even without a personal invitation from her friend.
- Pray for Gediminas as he seeks God’s clear guidance for his family.
 - Also pray that God would touch Danute's heart and draw her to salvation found in Christ.
- Outreach North America – Sojourner Church, Auburndale, FL (Rev. Patrick Daugherty)** *Patrick began his church planting journey as the Associate Pastor of Church Planting in Bartow. In April 2025, Bartow sent him to Auburndale to begin planting a daughter church.*
