SERMON NOTES

CHURCH COVENANT

Having, as we trust, been brought by divine grace to repent and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and to give up ourselves to him, and having been baptized upon our profession of faith, in the name of the Father and of the Son and the Holy Spirit, we do now, relying on His gracious aid, solemnly and joyfully renew our covenant with each other.

- 1. We will work and pray for the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. (Eph 4:3)
- 2. We will be devoted to one another in brotherly love. With humility and gentleness we will patiently bear with each other, forgiving, encouraging and building one another up, exercising watchfulness over each other and admonishing one another when necessary. (Luke 17:3; Col 3:13; 1 Thes 5:11; 1 Pet 1:22)
- 3. We will not neglect to gather together, or to pray for ourselves and others. (Col 4:2; Heb 10:25)
- 4. We promise to bring up our children and youth in the training and instruction of the Lord, and by a pure and loving example to seek the salvation of our family and friends. (Eph 6:4; 1 Pet 3:1)
- 5. We will rejoice with those who rejoice and weep with those who weep, helping to carry each other's burdens. (Rom 12:15)
- 6. We will seek, by God's help, to live carefully in this world, denying ungodliness and worldly passions. We will strive to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in this present age, as we wait for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ. (Titus 2:12: 1 Pet 1:14)
- 7. We will defend and maintain an evangelical ministry in this church by supporting and upholding:
 - The preaching of the Word of God (2 Tim 4:2)
 - The administration of the Gospel ordinances (baptism and the Lord's Supper) (Acts 2:38; 1 Cor 11:26)
 - The exercise of Church discipline (Matt 18:17; 1 Cor 5:13)
- 8. We will contribute cheerfully, generously and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the Gospel through all nations. (Matt 28:19; Luke 12:33; 2 Cor 9:7)
- 9. We will, when we move from this place, as soon as possible unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all. Amen. (2 Cor 13:14)

Grace Church - History

2013

God opens a door for UCCD to plant a church in Sharjah just north of Dubai. The pastors of UCCD send Anand Samuel to plant and pastor Grace Evangelical Church in Sharjah, UAE with Vaughn Marles as Pastoral Assistant. Grace Church begins as a small bible study in Anand's living room.

2014

Grace Evangelical Church holds her first inaugural service on January 17, 2014 with a core group of 20 people. On January 31, 2014 the church is officially constituted at their members meeting when they adopt a statement of faith, church covenant and constitution.

In February 2014, Grace Church baptizes two new members.

In September 2014, Samson Thomas moves to Grace Church to do his pastoral internship.

In October 2014, Grace Church installs their first Deacon of Ordinances, Alvo Dias

By the end of 2014 the membership is comprised of 31 members.

2015

Vaughn Marles leaves Grace Church and Samson Thomas joins as Pastoral Assistant in May 2015.

In September 2015, Grace Church, with great sorrow removes one of its members under church discipline.

By the end of 2015 the membership is comprised of 51 members.

2016

In June 2016, Alvo Dias, the Deacon of Ordinances relocates to India. In September 2016, Grace Church installs Binu Kuriakose as the new Deacon of Ordinances.

By the end of 2016 the membership is comprised of 53 members.

2017

In April 2017, Kirk Montgomery is nominated and voted to serve as Grace Church's first lay elder.

In December 2017, Grace Church installs Ryan Kingston as the Deacon of Welcome and Ushering.

By the end of 2017 the membership is comprised of 62 members

2018

In January 2018, Will Drake moves to Grace Church from Immanuel Baptist Church, Louisville, Kentucky.

In October 2018, Alex Cruz, Samson Thomas and Will Drake are nominated and appointed to serve as elders of Grace Church.

In October 2018, Grace Church bids farewell to Kirk Montgomery who relocates to the United States.

In Dec 2018, Grace Church installs Paul Ramos as the Deacon of Sound and Operations.

By the end of 2018 the membership is comprised of 69 members.
