Responsive Reading of the Law

Leader: You shall have no other gods before me. **All:** Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.

Leader: You shall not make for yourself an idol.

Congregation 1: God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and in truth.

Congregation 2: Christ Jesus is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

Leader: You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

All: Do not take an oath at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God, or by the earth, for it is his footstool.... Let what you say be simply "Yes" or "No"; anything more than this comes from evil.

All: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven.

Leader: You shall not commit adultery.

Men: Everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

Women: You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

Leader: You shall not steal.

All: Let the thief no longer steal, but rather let him labor, doing honest work with his own hands, so that he may have something to share with anyone in need.

Leader: You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Women: For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks...for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

Leader: You shall not covet.

All: Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions.
