CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN:

Gracious and Sovereign God,

We come before You today acknowledging our sin and the brokenness of our hearts. We confess that we have not always honored those whom You have appointed to lead and shepherd us. In our pride, we have been quick to criticize, slow to listen, and unwilling to submit to the authority You have established in the church and in our lives.

Forgive us, O Lord, for the times we have disrespected our leaders, whether through harsh words, ungrateful attitudes, or rebellious actions. We recognize that all authority is ultimately from You, and that when we dishonor those in leadership, we are dishonoring You, the One who ordains authority for our good and Your glory.

We have failed to recognize the weight of responsibility that rests upon the shoulders of those You have called to serve in leadership. We confess our impatience, our lack of trust, and our failure to support them in prayer and in love. Instead of submitting to their Godgiven authority, we have been tempted to exalt our own opinions and desires.

Father, we ask for Your forgiveness through the merits of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, who humbled Himself in perfect obedience to You. By His grace, we seek to learn humility, to grow in patience, and to submit to Your will in all things, especially in the way we treat those whom You have called to lead us.

We pray that You would give our leaders wisdom, strength, and courage to lead according to Your Word. May they shepherd us with integrity, faithfulness, and love. And may we, as Your people, respect them, encourage them, and follow them as they follow Christ.

We ask all of this in the name of Jesus Christ, our Savior and King. Amen.
