#### **CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN:**

Gracious God, on this day of thanksgiving, we pause to reflect on Your abundant blessings and to offer our praise. Yet, in the midst of our gratitude, we confess that we often take Your goodness for granted. We have failed to recognize the many gifts You provide, both seen and unseen, in our lives.

PROFESSION OF FAITH: The Nicene Creed (page 846 in red Trinity Hymnal)

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.
