Sermon Text: Luke 11:1-4

Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." 2 And he said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. 3 Give us each day our daily bread, 4 and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation."

Discussion Questions

1. Why do we need to be taught to pray? Is there a correct and incorrect way to pray? Explain.
2. When we pray, why is it important for us to remember we are speaking to our Father?
3. Why should the focus of our prayers be on God's name and God's kingdom, rather than on ourselves?
4. Why is it important to pray for our daily needs rather than for luxury and riches?
5. Jesus teaches us to pray for forgiveness and for protection from temptation. How does this help keep you humble? Why is humility important when we pray?
