Sermon Text: Luke 11:1-4

Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." 2 And he said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. 3 Give us each day our daily bread, 4 and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation."

Discussion Questions

- 1. Why do we need to be taught to pray? Is there a correct and incorrect way to pray? Explain.
- 2. When we pray, why is it important for us to remember we are speaking to our Father?
- 3. Why should the focus of our prayers be on God's name and God's kingdom, rather than on ourselves?
- 4. Why is it important to pray for our daily needs rather than for luxury and riches?
- 5. Jesus teaches us to pray for forgiveness and for protection from temptation. How does this help keep you humble? Why is humility important when we pray?
