

SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week of July 14, 2024

Sermon Text: Luke 24:36-43

[36] As they were talking about these things, Jesus himself stood among them, and said to them, "Peace to you!" [37] But they were startled and frightened and thought they saw a spirit. [38] And he said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? [39] See my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me, and see. For a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." [40] And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. [41] And while they still disbelieved for joy and were marveling, he said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?" [42] They gave him a piece of broiled fish, [43] and he took it and ate before them.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Why do you think it was so hard for the disciples to believe that Jesus had risen from the dead? Why is unbelief so slow to die?
- 2. Why is it comforting that Jesus' first words to His disciples is "Peace to you"?
- 3. Even after Jesus stands in front of them, doubt still arises in the disciples' hearts. How does Jesus respond to these doubts? Is doubting Jesus okay?
- 4. How does Jesus' patience and grace towards His disciples influence you and your response towards others? Describe the power of mercy, kindness, and a gentle answer.
- 5. Jesus was hungry and ate a piece of fish. What does this tell us about our future existence in heaven, and why is it important for believers to understand and believe this?
