LIFE CHALLENGE TRAINING

We hosted a three-day Life Challenge Training led by Stephen Hawkins from Oakridge Bible Chapel, with his daughter Susie assisting. Each day, 20-25 participants learned to share Christ with Sikhs, Muslims, and Mormons through practical classroom sessions and visits to a Gurudwara, Mosque, and local communities. The training emphasized Canada's multiculturalism and the need to engage with diverse backgrounds for effective Gospel outreach. 

BACK TO SCHOOL DRIVE

As the school year began, Hilltop Chapel organized a Back to School Drive in the Jamestown community, distributing around one hundred school bags filled with supplies and Bibles. Volunteers from the GTA contributed their time, highlighting the challenges of local neighborhoods, such as financial struggles and broken homes. The initiative aimed to address physical needs while pointing families to the spiritual support of the gospel. The outreach expanded to Orpington and Pittsboro with help from the City of Toronto, reflecting Christ's compassion for the vulnerable.
