You may have heard that one of our vision goals is the launch our city and life transformation center, HEART House, by December 31, 2025.

HEART House is a day center that offers a range of programs and services designed to support individuals in their personal and spiritual growth. These programs include personal growth workshops, self-care workshops, counseling and therapy, an adult learning lab, GED classes, credit repair classes, Bible studies, support group meetings, community meals, and transformation ministry training. The center provides a safe and supportive environment for individuals to focus on their inner well-being and spiritual connection to God.

HEART House's trained staff, facilitators, and therapists provide the tools and resources necessary for individuals to make positive changes in their lives and grow in their faith. •

Faith & Finances Graduation


