We believe that definition helps us to understand that the solution to all poverty is found in the healing relationship with our Maker, His people, and his creation. This exposes ALL of us, because we all suffer from brokenness and, by default, "poverty". Also, it requires that we need to intentionally spend time developing relationships that bring health to others. This summer, we were blessed to have a graduate intern from Florida State, and four undergrad interns from Covenant College. Here is what they said they learned this summer: "Brokenness is unique to every person." Therefore, "Poverty is complex" because WE are complex. Acknowledging this is key to working to alleviate poverty. It means we must always "listen and love people well" if we want to undo the unhealthy things that were done to our/their hearts. Finally, we must realize that "people have to care <u>about</u> themselves to start taking care <u>of</u> themselves." Simply, in helping others, we must first convince their hearts that their lives have value.


