## OUR VISION

Unfortunately, our current ministry space has not kept pace with this growth, and the classroom trailer is rapidly deteriorating. Replacing it with a permanent building—featuring a larger foyer, a dedicated nursery, well-designed classroom space, additional offices, and accessible restrooms—will provide a safe and welcoming environment where children can grow in faith, friendships can deepen, and our church family can warmly welcome others in the name of Christ.

Legacy is an invitation for our whole church family to take a step of faith together. Every prayer, every act of generosity, and every sacrifice is a declaration that Christ’s glory is worth our best.
