STATION 1 – Praise the LORD for the Leaders’ Offerings

Then *{after receiving the leaders’ offerings}* David said to all the assembly, “Bless the LORD your God.” And all the assembly blessed the LORD, the God of their fathers, and bowed their heads and paid homage to the LORD and to the king. And they offered sacrifices to the LORD, and on the next day offered burnt offerings to the LORD, 1,000 bulls, 1,000 rams, and 1,000 lambs, with their drink offerings, and sacrifices in abundance for all Israel. And they ate and drank before the LORD on that day with great gladness. (1 Chronicles 29:20-22)

- The evil one will attempt to cause division amongst us and discourage us with changes of plan and setbacks. LORD, help us remember this, recognize these occurrences for what they are, and use Your armor to persevere through these times.

STATION 3 – Protect and Transform Hearts

Then the LORD said to Moses, “See, I have chosen Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with wisdom, with understanding, with knowledge and with all kinds of skills— to make artistic designs for work in gold, silver and bronze, to cut and set stones, to work in wood, and to engage in all kinds of crafts. ... I have given ability to all the skilled workers to make everything I have commanded you.” (Exodus 31:1-5, 6b, NIV)
