<sup>9</sup> Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. <sup>10</sup> Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor. <sup>11</sup> Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. <sup>13</sup> Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality. <sup>14</sup> Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them. <sup>15</sup> Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. <sup>16</sup> Live in harmony with one another. ***"Guarding the True Gospel"***  
**1 Timothy 1:1-11 (p. 991)**  
**Barry Noll**

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by command of God our Savior and of Christ Jesus our hope, <sup>2</sup>To Timothy, my true child in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

<sup>3</sup>As I urged you when I was going to Macedonia, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine,

<sup>4</sup>nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which

promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith. <sup>5</sup> The aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith. <sup>6</sup> Certain persons, by swerving from these, have wandered away into vain discussion, <sup>7</sup> desiring to be teachers of the law, without understanding either what they are saying or the things about which they make confident assertions.

<sup>8</sup> Now we know that the law is good, if one uses it lawfully, <sup>9</sup> understanding this, that the law is not laid down for the just but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and sinners, for the unholy and profane, for those who strike their fathers and mothers, for murderers, <sup>10</sup> the sexually immoral, men who practice homosexuality, enslavers, liars, perjurers, and whatever else is contrary to sound doctrine, <sup>11</sup> in accordance with the gospel of the glory of the blessed God with which I have been entrusted.

2. Why did Paul leave Timothy in Ephesus (vv. 3-4)? What role does church leadership and the body of Christ in exercising this same type of ministry (1Tim. 4:16; Matt. 18:15-20; Acts 20:28; Eph. 4:11; 1 Pet. 5:1-5; Heb. 13:17)?
3. What does Paul indicate as the goal of apostolic teaching and the gospel (vs. 5; 2 Tim. 2:22)? How does your study of God's Word, prayer, and corporate worship foster this aim in your life (Col. 3:16; Eph. 5:18-21; Heb. 10:24-25)?
4. What are the results of false teaching in Ephesus (vv. 4, 6-7)? How have you seen the same effects in the modern church?
5. Why is the law good for lawless and disobedient people (vv. 9-10; Matt. 5:45; Rom. 13:3-4; 2 Thess. 2:6-7)? How does the gospel enable you to use the law lawfully in your life (vv. 8, 11; Matt. 22: 37-40; Rom. 3:20; 7:7-25; Gal. 6:1-2)?
