### ***Scripture Reading: Ephesians 2:1-10 (p. 976)***

<sup>1</sup> And you were dead in the trespasses and sins <sup>2</sup>in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience— <sup>3</sup>among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the flesh and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. <sup>4</sup> But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, <sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved— <sup>6</sup>and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, <sup>7</sup> so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. <sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through

***1 Timothy 1:12-20 (p. 991)***

<sup>12</sup> I thank him who has given me strength, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful, appointing me to his service, <sup>13</sup> though formerly I was a blasphemer, persecutor, and insolent opponent. But I received mercy because I had acted ignorantly in unbelief, <sup>14</sup> and the grace of our Lord overflowed for me with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. <sup>15</sup> The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost. <sup>16</sup> But I received mercy for this reason, that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display his perfect patience as an example to those who were to believe in him for eternal life. <sup>17</sup> To the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen. <sup>18</sup> This charge I entrust to you, Timothy, my child, in accordance with the prophecies previously made about you, that by them you may wage the good warfare, <sup>19</sup> holding faith and a good conscience. By rejecting this, some have made shipwreck of their faith, <sup>20</sup> among whom are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I have handed over to Satan that they may learn not to blaspheme.

1. What is one area of your life that you would like Jesus to change? How would you and others close to you know that prayers for God to change you are answered?
2. Why do you think the early church would be in disbelief when they first heard of Paul's conversion (vv. 12-14; Acts 9:1-19; Gal. 1:11-24; Phil. 3:4-7)? Who would you be most surprised to hear was changed by the gospel?
3. What does Paul attribute to the dramatic transformation in his life (vv. 15-17; Rom. 1:16-17; 1 Cor. 15:8-11 cf. Jn. 3:16-17)? How does the gift of daily repentance of sin bring gospel renewal and transformation in your life (Jn. 16:8; 1 Cor. 1:26-31)?
4. What charge has Paul given to Timothy (vv. 18-9a; 1 Tim. 1:3-7)? How does the Triune God equip you for spiritual warfare (2 Cor. 10:3-6; Eph. 6:10-20)?
5. How do the false teachers' end up apostatizing from Christ (vv. 19b-20; 1 Jn. 2:19)? What assurance does the Bible give to Christians that they will persevere to the end and not completely fall away from Christ (Lk. 22:31-34; Phil. 1:6; Heb. 12:1-2; Jude 24)?
