Sermon Notes

For Further Reflection:

1. Who is Tychicus and what is his relationship and purpose to Paul and the church (vv. 21-22; Col. 4:7-8; Acts 20:4; 2 Tim. 4:12; Titus 3:12)? How does prayer, correspondence, and visits by other Christians encourage your walk with Jesus?
2. How does what you wish for your loved ones reveal what is most important to you (Matt. 6:19-34; Lk. 6:44-45)? What does Paul specifically wish and pray for his readers (vv. 23-24)?
3. Where do you go to find peace? How does the biblical definition of peace compare and contrast your understanding of peace (vs. 23; 2:14-17; 6:15; cf. Num. 6:24-26; Jer. 29:11; Jn. 14:17; Rom. 5:1)?
4. What is the love that Paul prays for the Ephesians to have (vs. 23; 4:2-3; 5:2)? How does God's love for you enable to love *all* the saints, even you may not "like" (Eph.1:15-16; Rom. 5:5; 1 Jn. 4:19)?
5. How are both belief and trust necessary for saving faith (vs. 23; 1:15; 2:8; 3:12, 17; 4:5, 13; 6:16, 23; Heb. 11:1)? In what way is salvation by grace from the beginning to end in the Christian life (vs. 24; 1:2, 6, 7; 2:5, 7, 8; 3:2, 7, 8; 4:7, 29)?
