¹ Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ² "Honor your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), ³ "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land." ⁴ Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

For Further Discussion:

1. What motivation does Paul give for children to obey their parents (vv. 1-3; Col. 3:20; Ex. 20:12; Prov. 4:10; 10:27; cf. Prov. 23:22-26)? Why do you think it is significant that Paul lists disobedience to parents among the catalog of sins in which the wrath of God is being revealed (Rom. 1:30)?
2. What is the difference between obeying and honoring your parents (vv. 1-2)? How can adult children seeking to obey rather than honor their parents stunt their spiritual growth and lead to conflict with their spouse (Gen. 2:24)?
3. What are ways that a father can provoke his children to anger (vs. 4a; Col. 3:21)? How can either being a helicopter parent or negligent parent anger your children?
4. What are some specific ways that you sought to instill the discipline and instruction of the Lord in your home? (vs. 4b; 5:29; Deut. 6:7; 11:19; Prov. 22:6; 2 Tim. 3:15-17; Heb. 12:3-11)? How do you rely on God's grace in your parenting or when you feel like a failure as a parent (2 Cor. 5:14-15, 21; Titus 2:11-14; Gal. 5:6)?
5. How do the biblical commands that Paul gives to servants and masters in their household apply to Christians in the workplace (vv. 5-9)? What strength can you derive from the gospel to deal with difficult bosses or coworkers?
