Discussion Questions - These are a conversation starter and guide, not a script.

1. How did the Word becoming flesh resolve the problem of Exodus 33:20? What was the glory of Jesus that John was able to see (v. 14)? Jesus is *full* of both grace and truth. How does this make Him the most compelling person known to us?

2. In vv. 16-17, how does the fullness of Jesus become the source of all good in our lives? Why is it so important for us to trace all the gracious blessings we receive to the fullness of Jesus?

3. How was Jesus a superior means of God's revelation compared to Moses (v. 17)? What does it look like for someone to try to live for God on the basis of the law? What does it look like for someone to live for God on the basis of who Christ is?

4. In v. 18, how is Jesus uniquely qualified to make the Father known? It is not just the view of God that we are able to articulate that defines us, but the view of God that we actually believe in our hearts. What are the subtle lies about God that we might believe? How does looking to Jesus undo those lies?

5. What did God show and tell us about Himself in the Word becoming flesh?
