Discussion Questions - These are a conversation starter and guide, not a script.

1. In v. 20, why does the apostle John put such emphasis on John the Baptist's confession of who he was not? Why would John the Baptist be tempted to not make this confession? For us, how does reminding ourselves on a regular basis that "I am not the Christ" change how we live?

2. Who did John say he was in v. 23? How does John's view of himself inform how we should view ourselves? How might we order our lives so that we are pointing to the Lord in every area of our lives?

3. Why was John's answer in vv. 26-27 so appropriate to the question he was asked in v. 25?

4. How does John's answer of his unworthiness tell us about how he viewed the Lord? What does it tell us about how he viewed himself?

5. How might we cultivate a sense of the privilege that it is to serve the Lord? How does John's attitude help us in the various ways we serve the Lord? Think about these following situations: when ministry is going well, when I don't get what I want, when I am weary, when I am insulted or maligned.
